

Public Policy and Government Relations Report

This report covers the lobbying activities of Green Shield Holdings Inc. and all its subsidiaries for FY2025, as reflected in public lobbying disclosures and related internal governance processes. In this report, “GreenShield” refers to Green Shield Holdings Inc. and its subsidiaries. GreenShield engages in public-policy discussions on health, innovation-related regulatory frameworks, through direct interactions with public institutions and, where applicable, through industry associations and other collective platforms.

GreenShield engages governments at the federal, provincial and territorial level, abiding by local lobbying guidelines and laws. In FY2025, GreenShield engaged on public-policy matters disclosed in the lobbyist registries, related to improving access to health services (including mental health, prescription drugs, and dental care), strengthening virtual and community-based care, and ensuring appropriate fiscal and regulatory frameworks for health services and organizational operations, such as innovation. As disclosed in the lobbyist registries, these engagements involved federal health, finance, Indigenous services, revenue, and parliamentary institutions in Canada.

Where relevant, GreenShield participated in public-policy discussions through industry associations, in addition to its direct engagement with public institutions, including the Canadian Life and Health Insurance Association, provincial and federal Chambers of Commerce, and the Canadian Council of Innovators.

Under its policy, GreenShield does not make financial or in-kind political contributions, and none were made in FY2025.

This report is reviewed under the oversight of the Green Shield Holdings Inc. Board of Directors. As of June 2026, this report is publicly disclosed and updated on an annual basis.
